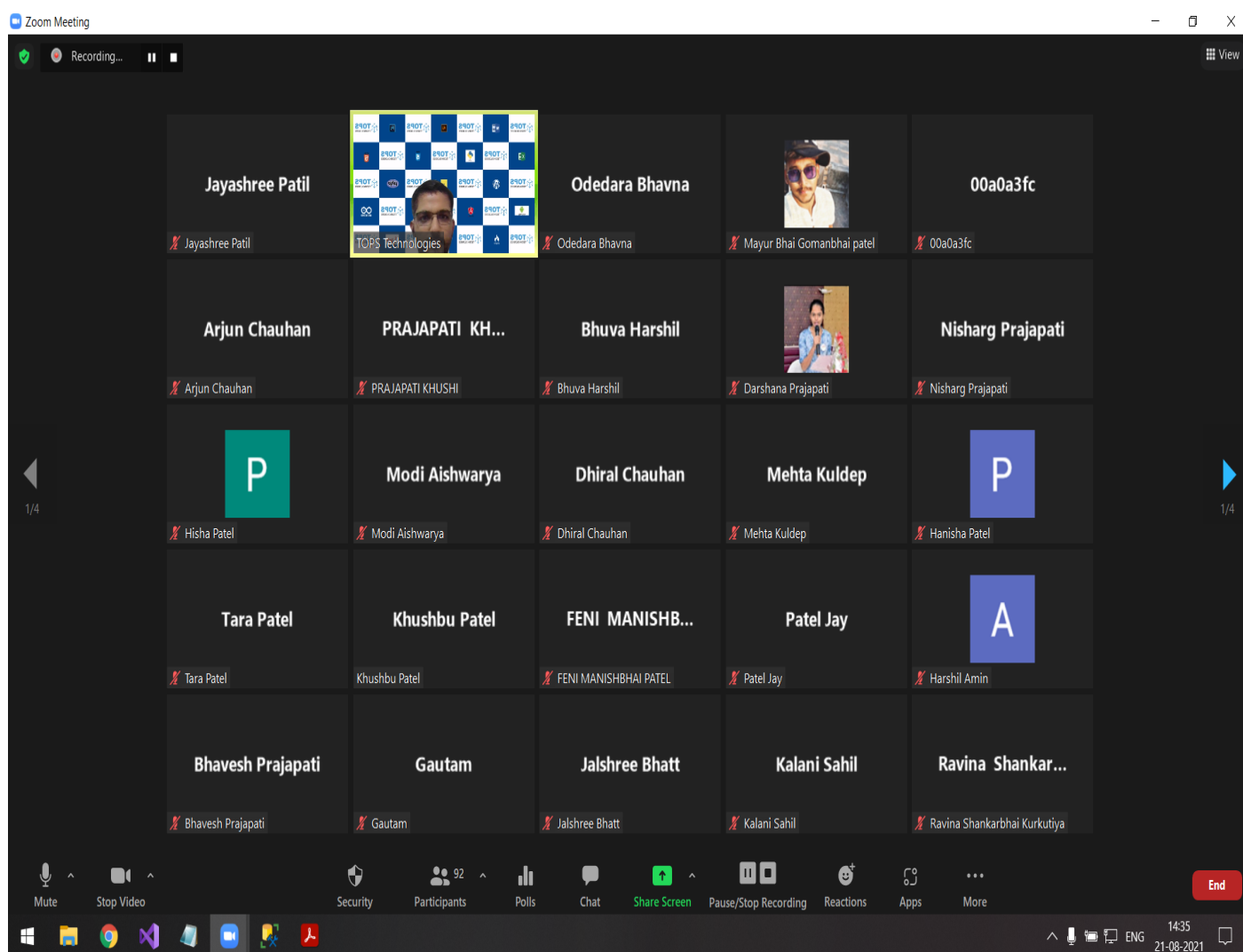

4. The Web Application Hacker's Handbook by Dafydd Stuttard & Marcus Pinto

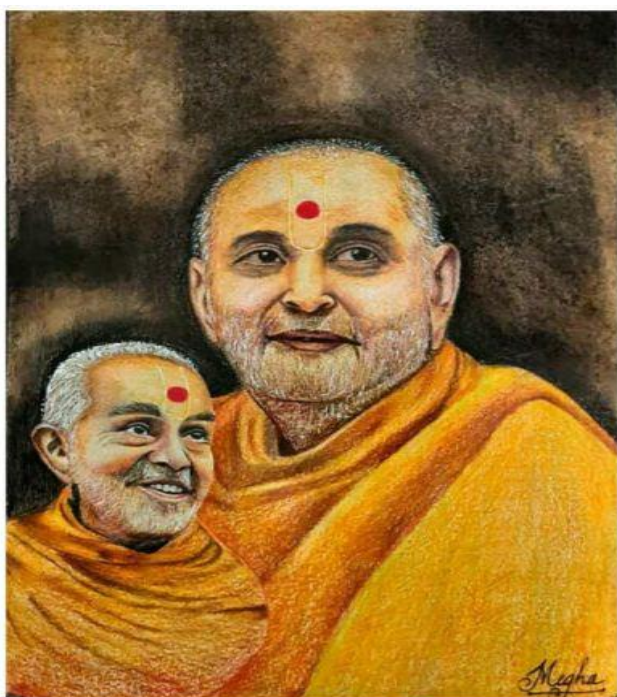

5. Hacking: The Art of Exploitation by Jon Erickson

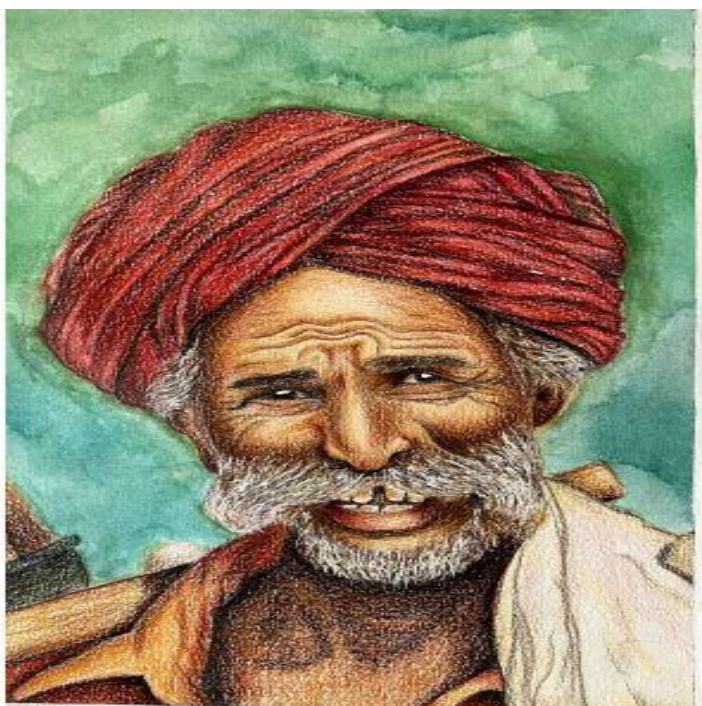

હિટાચી સી સાઇડ પાર્ક, જાપાન

ઓગસ્ટ, ૧૯૪૫માં અમેરિકાના બે ભસ્માસુર અણુશસ્ત્રોએ જાપાનને ઘૂંટણિયે લાવી દીધું હતું એ જાણીતી વાત છે. ઓછી જાણીતી હકીકત એ કે યુદ્ધ પૂરું થયા પછી પણ અમેરિકાએ જાપાનનો કેડો મૂક્યો નહોતો. જાપાનનાં કેટલાંક સ્થળોએ પોતાનાં લશ્કરી થાણાં બળજબરીપૂર્વક સ્થાપી દીધાં હતાં. આવું એક સ્થળ ટોકિયો શહેરની ઉત્તરે હિટાચીનામા હતું. દરિયાકિનારે વસેલા તે શહેરથી અમેરિકા પોતાનાં નવાં શસ્ત્રોનું પરીક્ષણ કરતું હતું. આ ક્રમ વર્ષો સુધી ચાલ્યો, જે દરમિયાન મિસાઇલર થયેલાં કેટલાંક રોકેટ તથા મિસાઇલ્સ હિટાચીનામા ખાતે રહેતા લોકોનાં મકાનો પર ત્રાટક્યાં. જાનમાલનું ખાસું નુકસાન કર્યું. આખરે છેક ૧૯૭૩માં અમેરિકાએ હિટાચીનામાનો હવાલો જાપાનને સુપરત કર્યો. ફાયરિંગ રેન્જની વિશાળ ભૂમિ પર જાપાની સરકાર બહુમાળી મકાનો તથા વસાહતો ઊભાં કરી શકી હોત. પરંતુ તેને બદલે એ સ્થળે શાંતિના પ્રતીક તરીકે ફૂલોનો બગીચો બનાવવામાં આવ્યો. આજે ૧૯૦ હેક્ટરમાં ફેલાયેલા તે પાર્કમાં વિવિધ ફૂલોની બિછાત જોવા મળે છે. પાર્કનું સૌથી મોટું આકર્ષણ એપ્રિલ-મે દરમિયાન ખીલી ઊઠતાં નેમોફિલિયા જાતિનાં ભૂરાં-જાંબુડિયાં ફૂલો છે. ફૂલોની સંખ્યા ૫૩ લાખ!

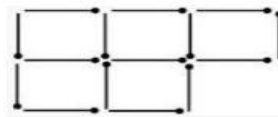

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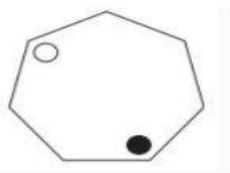
